

## **DIRECTIONS:**

Read *Full House* by Dayle Dodds

Print our printable and begin by reviewing the names of all the shapes, and then cut them out. Glue the large rectangle onto a 12 X 18 piece of construction paper. Glue the trapezoid on top of the rectangle and the rectangular prisms on the sides of the rectangle. The two pentagons go inside the trapezoid.

Have your child decide how many windows they want to glue onto the house. Then have each student decide how many they will color in yellow to represent someone in that room. Next instruct them to write the fraction of rooms that are filled on their paper. Glue on windows and then allow children to paint, color, and decorate the house as they choose.

Another option would be to write the fraction on the back and have the other children guess what the fraction is.

Printable, glue, scissors, paint, markers, or crayons
