

### Prep Work and Materials:

1. Print off two game boards on card stock paper and laminate.
2. Provide dry erase markers and two die with the six covered up so it shows zero.

### Directions:

#### Number line:

1. Players take turn rolling one die. They must say the number as a decimal, and then move up or down the number line that amount.  
(For example if a two is rolled, then the player may move up or down the number line by 2 tenths.)
2. Players must move the number they roll. If they can not move up the number line without going over one, they must move backwards.
3. A player wins when they are able to land exactly on one.

#### 100's grid

1. Players take turns rolling two dice. The player creates a decimal in the hundredths place, and then colors in or erases that many squares. (For example if a 3 and 6 is rolled the player may create .36 or .63)
2. Players must color or erase the number they roll. If they can not color in the number they created without going over one, they must erase that amount.
3. The First player to color in the one whole exactly wins.

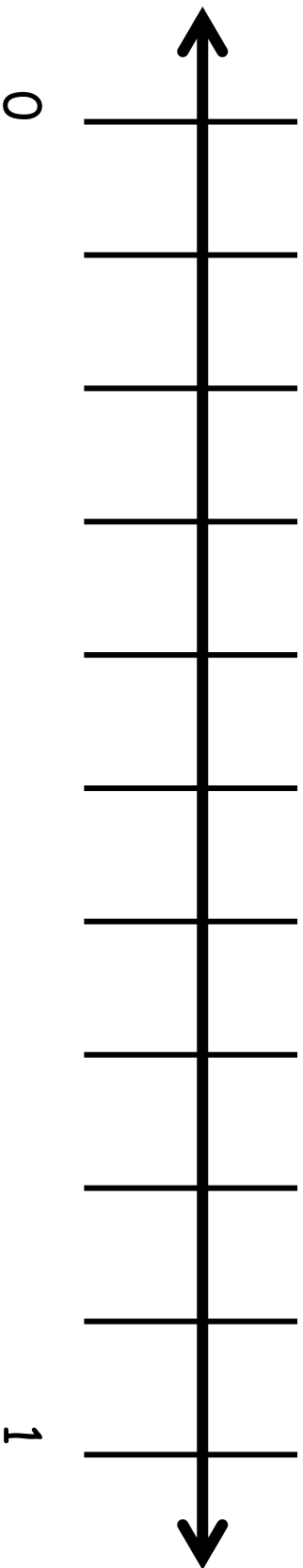

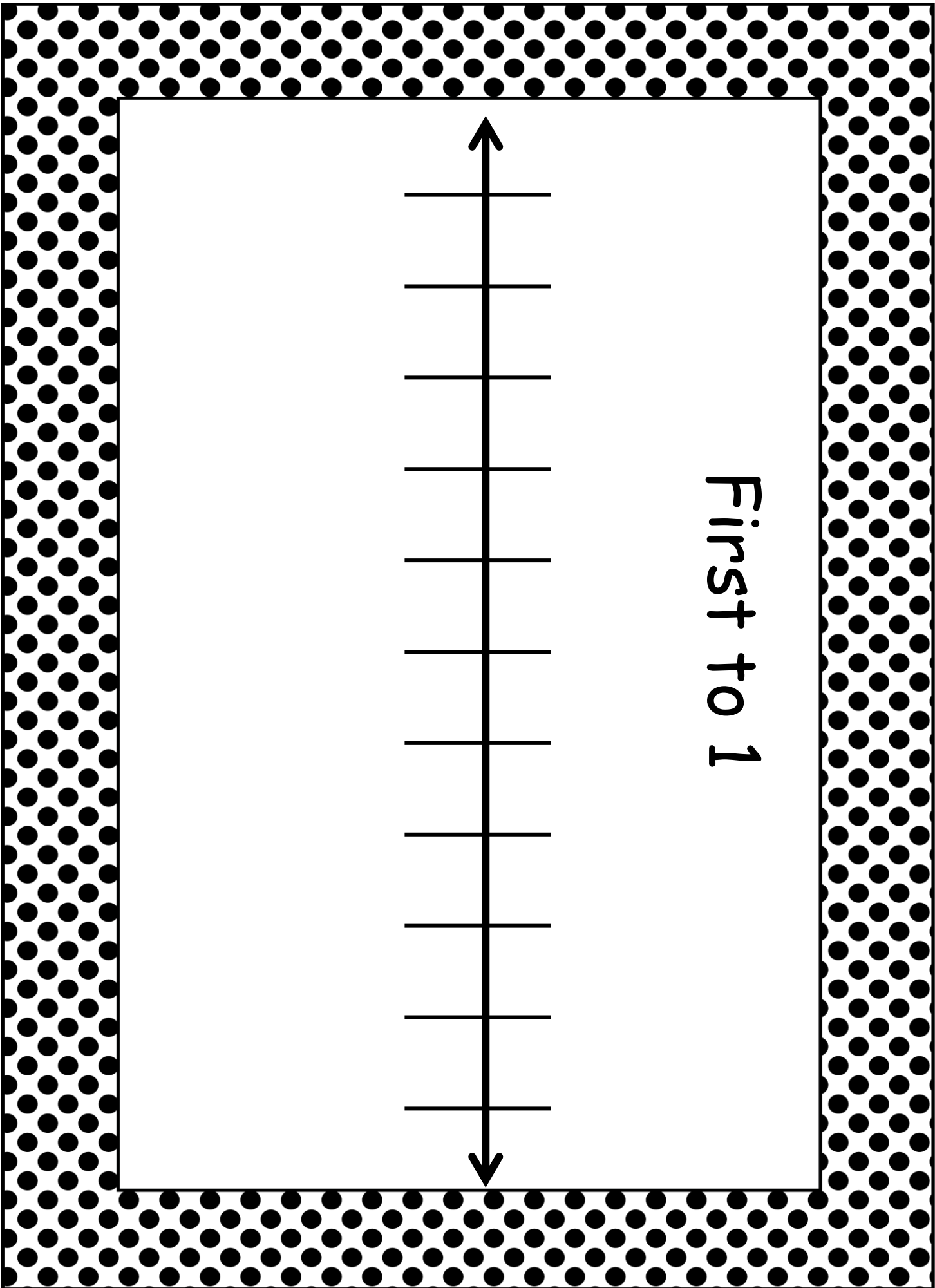
