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

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Elf Word Problems

Glitter Toes is in charge of making sure everything gets done. On his clipboard there are 45 lists and each list has 39 chores. How many chores need to be done?



3. During the last 22 days, McJingles made 1,056 wooden trucks. How many trucks did he make each day?



4. Tiny is in charge of sewing the bears together. It takes 89 stitches for each bear. If he sews 34 bears a day how many stitches will he sew in one day?



6. Garland gets to paint all the wooden toys. He has fifteen gallons of paint left. Each toy takes a cup of paint. How many gallons of paint will he have left after he paints 200 toys?



5. Tiny has made 36,312 stitches. How many bears will he have made?



7. Santa wanted to have 13,064 presents by the end of the month. How many presents do they need to make each day for 23 day to make this goal?



8. Winter made a huge mess with the ribbons. Each of the three rolls had 21 yards of ribbon. He got tangled up in 12 feet each of the ribbons, how much ribbon is left?



9. Every day Dash gets in a hurry, spills glue, and gets stuck. He has spent 23 minutes a day for the past 45 days stuck in glue. How many minutes has he been stuck in glue? How many hours?



10. The North Pole has tons of elves living there. Each room has six elves sleeping in it, and right now there are 49 rooms. But Santa wants to build on so that only two elves are in a room. How many rooms does he need to build?

6	$16 \times 15 = 240$ cups $240 - 200 = 40$ cups left over. $40/16 = 2 \frac{1}{2}$ gallons or 2 gallons and 8 cups.

8	Used up 36 feet of ribbon. There was a total of 63 yards or 189 feet of ribbon. $189 - 36 = 153$ feet of ribbon left.
9	$29 * 45 = 1,035$ minutes $1035/60 = 17$ hrs and 15 minutes
10	$49 \times 6 = 294$ $294/2 = 147$ $147-49 = 98$ more rooms
