
Adding to 20

Prep-Work:

1. Print off the Christmas tree and word problems.
2. Cut out the word problems
3. Provide pom poms.

Directions:

1. Have children read the problems and solve them by placing pom poms on the tree.



1. Dan put ornaments on the tree. He put on 3 red, 1 blue, and 1 green. How many ornaments did he put on the tree?

2. Jose only has 12 ornaments. He wanted to put on 6 red, 4 blue, and 3 yellow. If he only has twelve ornaments can he do this?

3. Susan has 15 ornaments that are red, yellow, and green. Seven are red, six are yellow, and the rest are green. How many are green?

4. Julie hung up three ornaments, Ling hung up seven, and Brighton hung up eight ornaments. How many ornaments are on the tree?

5. Alexander wants to put on 20 ornaments. He is going to use three different colors. How many of each color could he use?

6. Alexei put on three yellow ornaments, five blue, and twelve red. How many ornaments did he put on the tree.

7. Doug put ornaments on the tree. He put on 8 red, 5 blue, and 6 green. How many ornaments did he put on the tree?

8. Hong only has 18 ornaments. He wanted to put on 8 red, 6 blue, and 5 yellow. If he only has eighteen ornaments can he do this? Why?

9. Sierra has 19 ornaments that are red, yellow, and green. Seven are red, six are yellow, and the rest are green. How many are green?

10. Chen hung up four ornaments, Garcia hung up nine, and Anton hung up six ornaments. How many ornaments are on the tree?

11. Alexander wants to put on 18 ornaments. He is going to use three different colors. How many of each color could he use?

12. Mateo put on thirteen yellow ornaments, two blue, and five red. How many ornaments did he put on the tree?
