1. Sara has 15 stickers. She received 8 more stickers from her friend. How many stickers does Sara have now?
2. There are 30 books on the shelf. After buying 12 more books, how many books are there in total?
3. James bought a shirt for \$25 and a pair of pants for \$40. How much did he spend in total?
4. A bakery sold 50 cupcakes in the morning and 30 more cupcakes in the afternoon. How many cupcakes did they sell throughout the day?
5. The school had 500 students. After a new admission of 120 students, how many students are there now?
6. A car travels 100 miles on Monday and 150 miles on Tuesday. How many miles did the car travel in those two days?
7. A toy store had 80 stuffed animals. During a sale, they added 35 more stuffed animals. How many stuffed animals are there in the store now?
8. A farmer harvested 200 oranges and 350 apples. How many fruits did the farmer harvest in total?
9. Mary saved \$50 in the first week and \$75 in the second week. How much money did she save over two weeks?
10. In a game, John scored 15 points, and Sarah scored 12 points. How many points did they score in total?

11. There are 25 students in Class A and 30 students in Class B. How many students are there in both classes together?
12. Mike had 120 baseball cards. He received 35 more cards from his friend. How many baseball cards does Mike have now?
13. A store sold 50 red balloons and 70 blue balloons. How many balloons did they sell in total?
14. A train traveled 200 kilometers on Monday and 150 kilometers on Tuesday. How many kilometers did the train travel in those two days?
15. A school play has 80 actors in the first act and 50 more actors in the second act. How many actors are there in the entire play?
16. A pizza restaurant sold 150 pizzas on Saturday and 200 pizzas on Sunday. How many pizzas did they sell over the weekend?
17. There are 300 seats in a theater. After a recent renovation, 50 more seats were added. How many seats are there now?
18. Emily had 100 candies, and her brother gave her 30 more candies. How many candies does Emily have in total?
19. A company produced 500 widgets in the morning and 200 more widgets in the afternoon. How many widgets did they produce during the day?
20. A farmer had 40 cows and bought 25 more cows. How many cows does the farmer have now?
