2. The temperature in City A is 10 degrees Celsius, and in City B it is 12 degrees Celsius. Which city has a lower temperature?
3. Sarah ran 3.5 miles, and Mike ran 4.2 miles. Who ran a greater distance, Sarah or Mike?
4. A bag of oranges weighs 2.5 kilograms, and a bag of apples weighs 3 kilograms. Which bag is lighter the bag of oranges or the bag of apples?
5. The length of a rectangle is 10 meters, and the length of another rectangle is 12 meters. Which rectangle has a greater length?
6. Julie's age is 15, and Tom's age is 17. Who is older, Julie or Tom?
7. The population of City A is 500,000, and the population of City B is 650,000. Which city has a larger population?



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8. Mark's height is 165 centimeters, and Lisa's height is 172 centimeters. Who is taller, Mark or Lisa?

9. The price of a shirt is \$25, and the price of a pair of jeans is \$40. Which item is more expensive, the shirt or the jeans?

10. Sarah scored 85 on her math test, and John scored 92. Who had a higher score, Sarah or John?

11. The weight of a bag of rice is 10 kilograms, and the weight of a bag of flour is 8 kilograms. Which bag is heavier, the bag of rice or the bag of flour?

12. The length of a rectangular garden is 15 meters, and the width of another rectangular garden is 12 meters. Which garden has a larger area?
