4. If a boy has 68 apples and 21 oranges, how many fruits are there?
5. A magician has 75 rabbits and 28 parrots. How many animals does the magician have?
6. If a cat catches 59 mice and a dog catches 18, how many mice did they catch?
7. A teacher has 36 students in her class and 24 are in the field. How many students are there in the classroom?
8. If a person has 87 cents and finds a penny, how much money do they have?
9. A store has 56 toys on the shelf and receives a shipment of 42 more toys. How many toys are there in the store now?
10. John has 76 marbles and adds 28 more. How many marbles does John have?

11. John has 24 marbles, and his friend David gives him 37 more marbles. How many marbles does John have in total now?

12. Sarah has 58 stickers, and her sister gives her 12 more stickers. How many stickers does Sarah have in total?

13. In a toy store, there are 45 toy cars and 21 toy trains. How many toys are there in total?

14. Lisa has 67 baseball cards, and her friend Alex gives her 29 more cards. How many baseball cards does Lisa have now?

15. A box contains 54 red balls and 26 blue balls. How many balls are there in the box in total?

16. There are 33 students in the first grade and 25 students in the second grade. How many students are there in both grades?
