1. I am a number between 3,500 and 3,999. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 4,000. What number am I?
2. I am a four-digit number. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 9,000. My hundreds digit is twice my thousands digit. What number am I?
3. I am a number between 6,000 and 6,999. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 7,000. My tens digit is half of my thousands digit. What number am I?
4. I am a four-digit number. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 2,000. My ones digit is twice my hundreds digit. What number am I?
5. I am a number between 4,500 and 4,999. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 5,000. The sum of my thousands digit and my ones digit is 9. What number am I?
6. I am a four-digit number. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 8,000. My tens digit is three times my hundreds digit. What number am I?



1. I am a number between 1,200 and 1,799. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 1,000. The difference between my thousands digit and my ones digit is 3. What number am I?
2. I am a four-digit number. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 3,000. My tens digit is the same as my thousands digit. What number am I?
3. I am a number between 5,000 and 5,999. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 6,000. The sum of my thousands digit and my hundreds digit is 11. What number am I?
4. I am a four-digit number. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 7,000. My ones digit is three times my thousands digit. What number am I?
5. I am a number between 2,800 and 2,899. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 3,000. The sum of my thousands digit and my tens digit is 5. What number am I?
6. I am a four-digit number. When rounded to the nearest thousand, I become 1,000. The difference between my thousands digit and my ones digit is 7. What number am I?
