3. If a book has 92 pages, how many pages are there in 7 books?



4. In a month, a store sells 7 bicycles each day. How many bicycles will the store sell in 10 days?



5. Mary has 9 bags, and each bag has 7 apples. How many apples does Mary have in total?



6. If a pizza place can make 7 pizzas in an hour, how many pizzas can it make in 7 hours?



7. There are 18 chocolates in a box, and 7 boxes are kept in a store. How many chocolates are there in total?



8. In a game, a player scores 7 points each time they make a goal. If the player scored 63 points, how many goals did they make?



9. A factory produces 7 boxes of toys each hour. How many boxes of toys will the factory produce in 10 hours?



10. A truck can carry 7 boxes of apples. How many boxes of apples can the truck carry in 15 trips?



11. If a store sells 7 shirts each day, how many shirts will it sell in a week (7 days)?



12. There are 7 rows of chairs in a classroom, and each row has 10 chairs. How many chairs are there in total?



13. A restaurant can serve 7 customers at a time. How many customers can the restaurant serve in 4 hours?



14. If a book has 7 chapters, and each chapter has 19 pages, how many pages are there in the book?



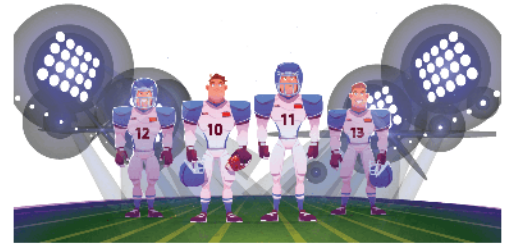
15. A family has 7 members. How many feet do they have in total?
