1. Emily had 15 apples. She gave some to her friend, and now she has 7 apples left. How many apples did Emily give to her friend?
2. There are 16 students in the class. 7 students are already sitting down. How many more students need to sit down?
3. Lisa has 14 marbles. She gave 6 marbles to her friend. How many marbles does Lisa have now?
4. Sarah has 9 stickers. Her friend gave her some more stickers. Now she has 17 stickers. How many stickers did her friend give her?
5. There were 23 birds on a tree. Some flew away, and now there are 15 birds left. How many birds flew away?
6. Jake had 25 toy cars. He sold some of them at a garage sale. Now he has 12 toy cars left. How many toy cars did Jake sell?

1. Rachel had 36 candies. She gave away 14 candies to her friends. How many candies does Rachel have now?

2. There are 47 seats in a movie theater. 19 seats are already filled. How many seats are still available?

3. A bakery sold 82 cupcakes in the morning. By the afternoon, there were 53 cupcakes left. How many cupcakes were sold during the afternoon?

4. Jason saved up 64 dollars. He spent some money on a new video game and now has 42 dollars left. How much did the video game cost?

5. There are 58 pages in a book. 26 pages have been read so far. How many pages are left to read?

6. In a toy store, there were 72 stuffed animals. 29 of them were bears. How many stuffed animals were not bears?
