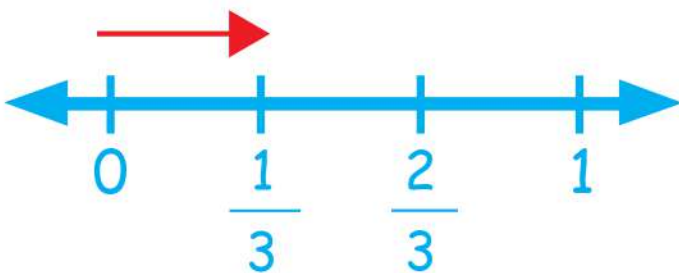
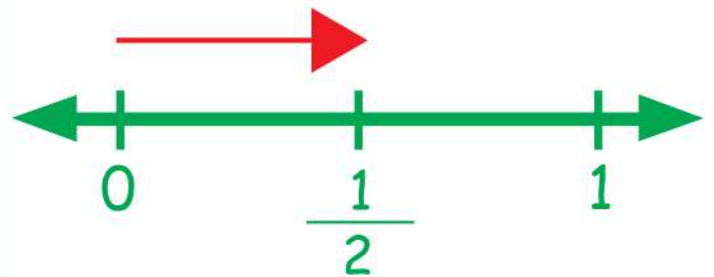


Comparing Fractions Using Number Line

Rules:

1. If a fraction is farther away from 0 on the number line, it is greater.
2. If a fraction is closer to 0 on the number line, it is smaller.

According to the number lines, $\frac{1}{2}$ is farther away from 0 than $\frac{1}{3}$.



According to the number lines, $\frac{1}{3}$ is closer to 0 than $\frac{1}{2}$.

$$\frac{1}{2} > \frac{1}{3}$$

A green crocodile mouth is drawn between the two fractions, with its head pointing towards the $\frac{1}{3}$ fraction, indicating that $\frac{1}{2}$ is greater than $\frac{1}{3}$.
