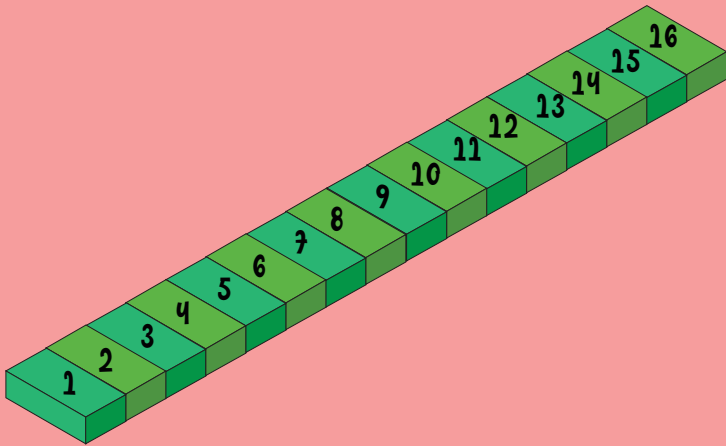


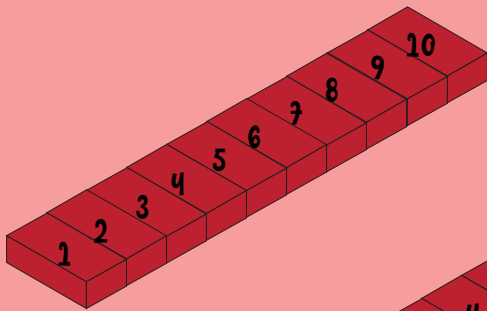
Gather Some Blocks

On one sunny morning, 16 students of your class went on a school trip. To explore a cave, you all need to cross a bridge. It's on your math teacher Mr. Samuel to check on all of you. To see the cave 10 of the students have crossed the bridge. How many have to cross yet so that Mr. Samuel's job is done perfectly?

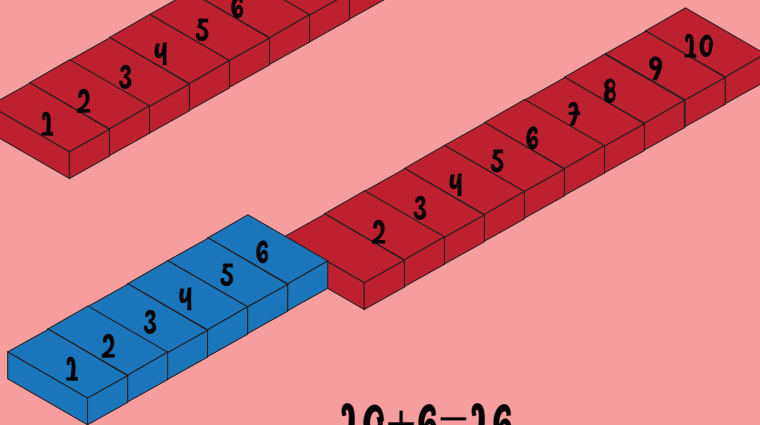


Make a bar with some blocks equal to whole that is 16.

Build the number of known blocks that is 10



Add number of blocks to make both the bar a equal length



$$10 + 6 = 16$$

So, 6 students are yet to cross.
