1. Sarah had some slices of cake. She gave 3 slices to her friends, and now she has 5 slices left. How many slices did she have?

2. Emily baked some cupcakes for the party. Her friends ate 9 cupcakes. After the party, there are only 4 cupcakes left. How many cupcakes did she make?

3. Alex had some pieces of cake. He ate 3 pieces and now has 4 pieces left. How many pieces of cake did Alex have?

4. Lisa baked some cookies. She sold 10 of them and now has 7 cookies left. How many cookies did Lisa make?

Solve the Following Word Problems

1. There were some slices of cake on the table. During the party, 9 slices were eaten and 9 slices were left. How many slices were there on the table at the beginning?

2. Jake bought a whole cake that had certain number of slices. He shared 11 slices with his family and now has 5 slices left. How many slices did the cake have at the beginning?

3. Mia received a box of some chocolates. She ate 10 chocolates and now has 20 chocolates remaining. How many chocolates did the box contain?

4. Daniel had some marshmallows. He used 12 of them in making s'mores and now has 18 marshmallows left. How many marshmallows did Daniel have in the first place?

Solve the Following Word Problems

1. Sophie had some pieces of candy. She gave away 9 pieces and now has 6 pieces left. How many pieces of candy did Sophie have at the beginning?
2. At the bake sale, there were some donuts. By the end of the sale, 28 donuts were sold and 22 donuts were there. How many donuts were did the shop have in the first place?
3. Liam had some gummy bears. He shared 37 with his sister and now has 23 gummy bears left. How many gummy bears did Liam have in the first place?
4. Rachel baked some muffins. She packed 25 muffins for school lunches and now has 9 muffins remaining. How many muffins did Rachel make?
