1. Emily had 15 apples. She gave some to her friend, and now she has 7 apples left. How many apples did Emily give to her friend?
2. A bakery had 98 cupcakes. They sold 53 cupcakes during a sale. How many cupcakes are left in the bakery?
3. Sarah has 64 stickers. She used some of them to decorate her notebook, and now she has 29 stickers left. How many stickers did Sarah use for decorating?
4. In a toy store, there were 87 toy cars. After some were sold, there are 46 toy cars remaining. How many toy cars were sold?
5. Michael had 120 marbles. He lost some of them while playing and now has 85 marbles left. How many marbles did Michael lose?
6. Lisa had 235 books in her collection. She lent some to her friend, and now she has 159 books left. How many books did Lisa lend to her friend?

1. A school had 512 students last year. This year, some students graduated, and now there are 389 students. How many students graduated?

2. There were 76 balloons at a party. Some of them popped during the party, and there are 45 balloons left. How many balloons popped?

3. Amy had 150 candies. She shared some with her siblings and now has 98 candies left. How many candies did Amy share?

4. There were 287 seats in a movie theater. Some people left, and now there are 164 people seated. How many people left the theater?

5. Julie had 68 dollars. She spent some money shopping and now has 24 dollars left. How much money did Julie spend while shopping?

6. A farmer had 345 eggs in a basket. Some eggs broke, and now there are 187 eggs left. How many eggs broke?
