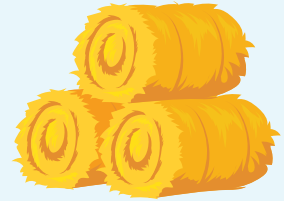


1. A farmer has 98 bales of hay, but he needs to use 56 bales for his livestock. How many bales of hay does he have left?



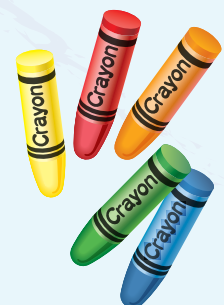
2. A company has 73 employees working on a project, but 48 of them have to leave for another project. How many employees are left on the first project?
