

1. Sarah has 34 marbles and her brother has 27 marbles. How many marbles do they have together? If Sarah loses 8 marbles, how many marbles will remain?



2. A company has 89 employees, but 27 of them are on vacation. 21 employees join as a new recruit. How many employees are at work?



3. A grocery store has 78 apples and 32 oranges. Among them, 22 fruits are sold. How many pieces of fruit are there in total?



4. A farmer harvested 65 pumpkins, 22 broccolis and sold 18 of them. How many vegetables are left?



5. A classroom has 26 students and the teacher buys 37 more chairs. How many chairs are there in total? Another 22 students join in that class. How many seats will remain empty?



6. A pizza restaurant sold 53 pizzas for lunch and 46 pizzas for dinner. 56 pizzas are sold in that day. How many pizzas remained?



7. A company has a budget of \$300, but they spend \$112 on supplies. How much money is left in the budget? Again they get a revenue of 226 dollars. How much money will remain now?



8. A park has 54 trees, but 19 of them were removed due to disease. New 28 trees are set in that park. How many trees are in the park now?
