1. Sarah has 14 boxes of cookies, and each box contains 7 cookies. How many cookies does she have in total?
2. A bookstore sells 18 books in a day. If each book costs \$5, how much money do they earn in a day?
3. There are 15 students in a classroom, and each student needs 3 pencils. How many pencils are needed in total?
4. A farmer has 12 baskets, and each basket holds 9 apples. How many apples does the farmer have in all the baskets?
5. Jenny is making bracelets, and she needs 8 beads for each bracelet. If she wants to make 25 bracelets, how many beads does she need?
6. A toy store has 11 shelves, and each shelf can hold 6 toy cars. How many toy cars can the store display?

1. There are 9 bags of marbles, and each bag contains 7 marbles. How many marbles are there in total?
2. A bakery bakes 14 pies, and each pie serves 8 people. How many people can they serve with these pies?
3. A gardener planted 17 rows of flowers, and each row has 6 flowers. How many flowers are there in the garden?
4. There are 13 rows of chairs in an auditorium, and each row has 5 chairs. How many chairs are there in total?
5. Tommy collected 16 seashells at the beach, and each of his friends received 4 seashells as a gift. How many friends did he give seashells to?
6. Lisa wants to buy 10 packs of stickers, and each pack contains 9 stickers. How many stickers will she have in total?
